DID YOU KNOW...

- Federal law requires that the individual cost of all class materials must be listed on the district's online class schedule by July 2016.
- Timely adoption of books will enable the bookstore to buy them back at a higher rate & rent or sell them used to students at a reduced rate.
- Timely submission of your textbook information better ensures course materials will be available for the first day of class.
- Making late changes to your textbook orders can increase the cost to students.
- Bundling your materials or using custom editions may increase the cost to students by limiting their ability to purchase used books or selling books back.
- All electronic materials must be ADA compliant - contact DSPS for assistance.
- Free open source, peer reviewed, quality textbooks are available for many disciplines. Contact the bookstore for information.
